TOURNAMENT ENTRY RULES

Entry fee:

Teams with 4 players on the roster: \$100
Teams with 5 players on the roster: \$125
(All participants who pre-register will receive event T-shirt)

Roster limits: minimum 4 players, maximum 5 players.

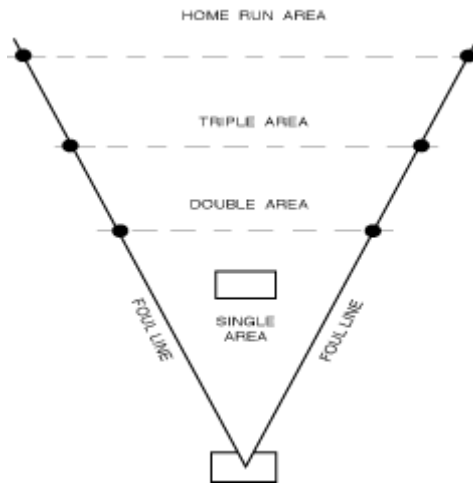
All Players must sign the Waiver of Liability.

Tournament will run in double-elimination bracket format with random drawing for position.

WIFFLE perforated plastic balls and WIFFLE bats must be used exclusively in all tournament games, and will be provided on the day of the event.

GAME RULES

The field will look like this:



Teams will field 4 players (a pitcher responsible for the single zone and 3 fielders, one fielder in each of the other zones) and may include up to 5 players in their batting order. Of the four players in the field, each of the four zones will be fielded by a player. Fielders cannot move from one zone to another. They can only defend their own zones. If teams have 5 players on the roster, teams can make unlimited substitutions and position changes in the field during the game.

Regular pitching count rules apply regarding balls, strikes and foul balls.

A pitch that hits the “strike zone board” behind home plate is a strike. A pitch that misses the board is a ball.

Hitters that come to bat out of batting order will result in an out.

Three outs to retire a side per half inning

A hit ball that lands in foul territory is considered foul. A ball that enters into foul territory prior to passing the line separating the single and double zone is considered foul. A ball that lands in fair territory and then enters into foul territory AFTER passing the single / double line is considered fair (similar to a baseball rolling past third base in fair territory and then entering into foul territory).

An out for the batter can be made in three ways:

1. The batter can strike out if he/she swings at a pitched ball and does not foul tip the 3rd strike, or if a pitch hits the “strike zone board” for a 3rd strike.
2. Fly balls caught in fair or foul territory.

3. Ground balls (defined as any ball that initially bounces in the single zone, no matter the trajectory) caught while the ball is in motion (in fair territory if in the single zone, or in fair or foul territory if ball is ruled fair and ball is past the single/double line regardless of which zone the ball is fielded in) will be considered an out. A ball that lands past the single zone is ruled a fly ball, and is ruled dead upon impact with the ground. Bunting is not allowed.

Hitters do not run, and there will be no base runners. A ball hit in the single zone and not caught or fielded cleanly while the ball is in motion will constitute a single. A ball hit into the double zone and not caught will constitute a double, and the same rules apply for the triple and home run zones.

Base running – the imaginary runners advance in accordance with how many bases a hit earns. If the batter hits a single, any imaginary base runners advance one base. On a double, 2 bases, etc. Runners and outs will be kept track of by official game scorers.

Each game will be 5 innings with the home team determined by coin flip prior to the game. If the game is tied after 5 innings, extra inning rules apply.

* number of innings subject to vary depending on time restrictions
